

## Back to Basics

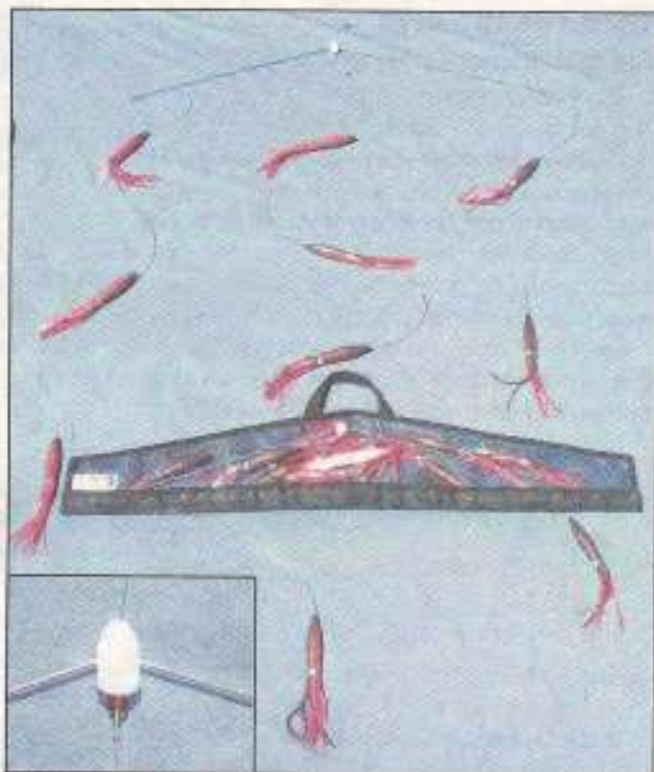
Tournament Grade Tackle unveils their latest spreader bar

While spreader bars have been around for years, the folks at Tournament Grade Tackle have developed the ultimate dual function day and night spreader bar. The new "Delta Bar" is swept back and machined from premium stainless steel stock so it tracks perfectly and is much less tangle and trouble prone than other bars. The streamlined design utilizes fewer parts that will corrode, wear out, break or otherwise fail when it counts the most. This translates to minimal swivels and sleeves to replace. All rigging beads are glass so there is no chemical reaction between soft plastic squid and hard plastic beads. In fact, a light freshwater rinse every so often is all that's required to ensure that the Delta Bar will provide years of trouble free and dependable service.

The squids on every Tournament Grade Tackle Spreader Bar are rigged with durable nylon crimps, which totally eliminates any nicking, pinching, cutting and wearing of leader material. In addition, the bullet-shaped blocks provide much less drag than conventional square blocks. The hydrodynamic blocks dive in and out of chop with ease and the angled bar slices through turbulent seas like the wings of a hydroplane.

For low-light situations the Delta Bar is available with a glow stinger squid that will glow for a full 8 hours or more. For darker conditions, as well as dead-of-night presentations, the "Night Bar" also new from the Linden, New Jersey-based company has proven deadly for a variety of applications. Special bioluminescent squid duplicate the natural tendencies of live squid when excited. They will also glow for 8 hours or more and are offered in single, daisy chain or spreader bar configurations.
